**We are taking steps to disinfect our lobby throughout the day. Some of these items include:**

- Hand Sanitizer in the lobby and at the desks/teller stations of all employees.
- Tellers are being supplied with disposable sanitary gloves.
- Wiping down counters several times a day.
- Reviewing disaster recovery plans and preparing should the branch need to be closed or have limited access.

- It's a good idea to setup direct deposit of your paycheck, reoccurring deposits or automatic bill payments.
- If you have not activated your credit or debit card, please do so now! If you need to have your PIN reset, please call us at 906-632-4210.
- If you do not have an ATM or Debit Card, contact the Credit Union to request one.
- If you do not have a FECCCU Credit Card, consider applying today. The Credit Union has great rates and a fast approval process.

**Here's What You Can Do To Stay Healthy**

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) recommends everyday preventive actions to help prevent the spread of respiratory diseases including:

- Avoid close contact with people who are sick.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth.
- Stay home when you are sick.
- Cover your cough or sneeze with a tissue, then throw the tissue in the trash.
- Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces using a regular household cleaning spray or wipe.
- Facemasks should be used by people who show symptoms of COVID-19 to help prevent the spread of the disease to others. The use of facemasks is also crucial for health workers and people who are taking care of someone in close settings (at home or in a health care facility).
- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, especially after going to the bathroom; before eating; and after blowing your nose, coughing or sneezing.
